

GOD PARTED THE RED SEA

Exodus 13-15

DOES GOD KEEP HIS PROMISES? YES, GOD ALWAYS KEEPS HIS PROMISES BECAUSE HE IS FAITHFUL.

Moses quickly led God's people out of Egypt toward the Red Sea. God went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud during the day. At night, God was in a pillar of fire.

God knew Pharaoh was going to change his mind, and God had a plan to prove He is the one true God.

Pharaoh got into his chariot, and he and his army caught up with God's people.

The Israelites were afraid. "We are going to die!" they shouted.

But Moses said, "Don't be afraid. God will fight for you."

God told Moses what to do: "Stretch out your hand over the sea, and divide it so the Israelites can go through the sea on dry ground." The Israelites walked through with walls of water on both sides.

The Egyptians chased after them. On the other side of the sea, Moses stretched out his hand again. The waters crashed down, killing all of Pharaoh's army.

When the Israelites saw what had happened, they feared God.

Christ Connection: Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt, and God provided a way for them to escape through the Red Sea. The Bible says that Jesus is greater than Moses. (Hebrews 3:3) People who trust in Jesus escape the penalty of sin and have eternal life.
