NUMBERS 16:1-50

"One day Korah son of Izhar, a descendant of Kohath son of Levi, conspired with Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and On son of Peleth, from the tribe of Reuben. ²They incited a rebellion against Moses, along with 250 other leaders of the community, all prominent members of the assembly [...]

F. THE DAUGHTERS OF ZELOPHEDAD

NUMBERS 27:1-11

27 One day a petition was presented by the daughters of Zelophehad—Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah. Their father, Zelophehad, was a descendant of Hepher son of Gilead, son of Makir, son of Manasseh, son of Joseph.

G.THE POSITION OF DAUGHTERS

1.A <u>PETITION</u> WAS MADE BY WOMEN WHO WERE SISTERS.

2. THEY <u>STOOD</u> BEFORE MOSES, ELEAZAR THE PRIEST, THE TRIBAL LEADERS, AND THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY.

3. THEY <u>DEFINED</u> THE RELATIONSHIP WITH THEIR FATHER BEFORE THE PEOPLE AND FOR THEMSELVES.

4. THEY CHALLENGED THE STATUS QUO WITH QUESTIONS THAT WERE NOT ASKED BEFORE.

5. THEY DEMANDED THEIR FATHER'S PROPEROTY FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR LOVED ONES.
